Join us for this 1 hour program with dancers from American Midwest Ballet. We'll hear the story, see a performance, learn a dance, and have time for Q&A.

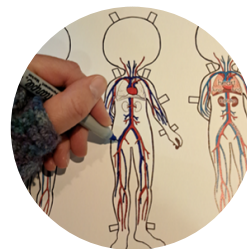
